

A special meeting of the Geneseo Town Board was held on Thursday, September 17, 2009 in the conference room of the Geneseo Town Office Facility.

MEETING OPENING

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The main purpose of the meeting was to discuss the draft of the 2010 budget. Before the discussion there were some minor items mentioned.

POLLING PLACE AT LONG POINT PARK

Councilman Manapol reported that he has spoken with the Board of Elections regarding the use of the museum at Long Point Park as a polling place. Since there are so many regulations that cannot be met at the museum, the polling place will remain at the Town Highway Facility.

PUBLIC MEETING ON WATER RATE INCREASE

Councilman Dimpfl made a motion to schedule a public hearing on the proposed water and sewer rate increases for the October 8, 2009 Board meeting; second by Councilman Manapol; motion carried 5-0.

2010 DRAFT BUDGET

The Board reviewed the draft budget and discussed changing several items. A revised draft will be prepared and discussed again at the meeting on Thursday, September 24, 2009.

RELOCATION OF TOWN/VILLAGE COURT FACILITY

Councilman Tenalio reported that after numerous discussions with Town and Village representatives, any relocation of the Court facility will be put on hold until a renovation of the Village Building on Main Street is imminent. This will probably be 1 to 2 years from now. In the meantime, the Court facility is sufficient for their needs.

ADJOURNMENT

Councilman Dwyer made a motion to adjourn the meeting; second by Councilman Manapol; motion carried 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
