

A Special Meeting of the Geneseo Town Board was held on Thursday, June 24, 2010 in the conference room of the Geneseo Town Office Facility.

MEETING OPENING, APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Supervisor Wadsworth called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. The flag was pledged and a moment of silence was held for service men and women serving around the world. At this time Councilman Manapol arrived.

The Board reviewed and amended the minutes of June 10th. Mr. Taylor moved and Ms. Irwin seconded the motion to approve the minutes of June 10, 2010 as amended. Motion passed with voting as follows: Wadsworth-aye; Dwyer-aye; Taylor-aye; Irwin-aye; Manapol-aye. Nays: None.

CONESUS LAKE WATER SAMPLING:

The funding provided by the Conesus Lake Association and Livingston County for testing water entering the lake at the Cottonwood/Booher Hill Road section of Conesus Lake has been depleted. The Board discussed providing additional funds for up to three (3) additional samplings to be taken during high rain events between now and July 16th. The cost for each sampling event is approximately \$700, making the total maximum cost for this proposal \$2,100. Four lake residents in the Booher Hill Road area have been trained and are taking the samplings, and would continue to do so, along with the support and assistance from the county's health department.

Mr. Dwyer moved that, as a one-time courtesy to the taxpayers on Conesus Lake, the board authorize the expenditure of funds not-to-exceed \$2,100 for up to three (3) sample tests of high-rain events between now and July 16th at the Cottonwood/Booher Hill Road section of Conesus Lake. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion and it passed with voting as follows: Wadsworth-aye; Dwyer-aye; Taylor-aye; Irwin-aye; Manapol-aye. Nays: None.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Notification of a Village ZBA hearing for a variance request to build a deck at 4 Dorchester Drive was in board packets. There were no comments on this request at this time.

ADJOURNMENT:
