MEETING OPENING, APPROVAL OF MINUTES AND VOUCHERS:

Supervisor Wadsworth called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. The allegiance to the flag was pledged and a moment of silence was held for the service men and women serving our country around the world. Congratulations were extended to Supervisor Wadsworth for his appointment as Deputy Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors.

The Board reviewed the minutes of October 25th. Mr. Taylor moved and Mr. Wrubel seconded the motion to approve the minutes of October 25, 2012 as presented. Motion passed with voting as follows: Wadsworth-aye; Taylor-aye; Wrubel-aye; Irwin-aye; Manapol-aye. Nays: None.

The Board reviewed the abstract of vouchers. Ms. Irwin moved and Mr. Manapol seconded the motion to approve payment for vouchers #817 thru #891 on voucher abstract #11, in the following amounts:

TEMPLE HILL CEMETERY:

Supervisor Wadsworth reported that the highway crew has been working on the existing roadways in the Temple Hill Cemetery and that the cemetery is requesting that the Town build a new roadway at the east end of the cemetery, from Route 20A to Center Street. Discussion was held on this issue and it was agreed that Highway Superintendent Levey should provide the Board with an estimate of the cost to make this improvement to the cemetery and that cemetery representatives be requested to attend a Town Board meeting to discuss their request.

ZONING CODE REVISION PROJECT:

Supervisor Wadsworth reported that Councilman Wrubel, Planning Board Members David Woods and Dwight Folts, Heather Ferrero from Livingston County Planning Department and himself met to review

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the proposals that were received for the zoning code revision project. Cost for most of the proposals submitted ranged from \$47,000 to \$52,000. It is planned that the committee will interview firms in three (3) weeks.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Also included in Board packets was the October Code Enforcement Office report. CLA Representative Al Dietrich thanked the Board for their continued support of Conesus Lake and Conesus Lake Association.

A letter from Tim Sullivan to the Supervisor and Town Board had been submitted at the beginning of the meeting. The letter was passed around the board table for all Town Board Members to read.
