MEETING OPENING & APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Supervisor Wadsworth called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The flag was pledged and a moment of silence was held for the men and women serving around the world.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

CONESUS LAKE/LONG POINT PARK:

The board members will review the draft policy for reservations at Long Point Park. The policy will be reviewed at a future meeting.

Vince DiSalvo informed the board members that the William G. Palmeroy sign has been ordered. Additional historical markers are still being looked into. The town board will determine where the sign is to be located.

Joseph Ferrero stated that Friends of Long Point has been working on promotional items for swimming at Long Point Park. Any promotions regarding Long Point Park will not be sent out prior to obtaining board approval.

HIGHWAY/WATER/SEWER:

Supervisor Wadsworth informed the board members that the Livingston County Department of Health has provided a report on a well water study that was performed on Lima Road. This report will be sent to MRB Group.
