MEETING OPENING, APPROVAL OF MINUTES & ABSTRACT OF VOUCHERS:

SURPLUS OF SHELVING:

MISCELLANEOUS:

Games of chance are not currently permitted within the town of Geneseo. Legal will be providing information shall the town decide to authorize games of chance.

Notebook Tek will be providing a quote for iPads. If purchased, the devices will be sent directly to the town office from the supplier.

John Steinmetz provided the board members with some insight on the possible rezoning of a parcel on Genesee Street. Mr. Steinmetz recommended contacting NYSDOT, a planner, engineer, and a traffic engineer to get them involved in the process. Pedestrian safety is something that needs to be considered, especially with the recent statistics that show pedestrian deaths at an all-time-high.
