### **MEETING OPENING, APPROVAL OF MINUTES & ABSTRACT OF VOUCHERS:**

Deputy Supervisor Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The flag was pledged and a moment of silence was held for the men and women serving around the world and the people in Italy.

Councilman Griffo moved and Councilwoman LaVigne seconded the motion to approve the minutes of August 11, 2016, as presented. Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: None.

### **TOM HILL RE: GENESEO WEBSITE:**

Tom Hill approached the board to discuss the revisions he has been making to the government website: [www.geneseony.org](http://www.geneseony.org). Mr. Hill distributed copies of an email that was sent to board members earlier in the week. Mr. Hill asked the board members for their comments and questions on the revisions and welcomed more ideas. Councilwoman Irwin and Clerk Kennedy will meet to talk about additional revisions.

### **COMPREHENSIVE REZONING:**

Councilman Wrubel moved and Councilwoman LaVigne seconded the motion to schedule a public hearing on the Comprehensive Rezoning project for October 27, 2016 at 7:15 p.m. at Long Point Park, Geneseo, NY. Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: None.

### **OFFICE SECURITY:**

Councilwoman LaVigne informed the board members of a recent quote that was obtained for security equipment to be placed in the Town Office. The board members will review the lease with Livingston County for the office space to see if any additional options exist. Additionally, the entities that would receive security alerts will be contacted.

### **CONESUS LAKE/LONG POINT PARK:**

Councilwoman LaVigne moved and Councilman Wrubel seconded the motion to adopt the **Long Point Park Rules and Regulations** as presented and attached to the official minute book. Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: none.

After discussing various revisions, Councilman Wrubel moved and Councilwoman LaVigne seconded the motion to adopt the Sale of Alcohol Policy Rule and Regulations as follows:

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### TOWN OF GENESEO LONG POINT PARK - SALE OF ALCOHOL POLICY RULES AND REGULATIONS (Established August 25, 2016)

Policy Statement: The sale of alcohol on the Town of Geneseo owned property at Long Point Park is allowed by special permit only. An Alcohol permit application may be obtained from the Geneseo Town Clerk.

1. A permit is required to sell alcoholic beverages at Long Point Park. The permit fee is \$75.00.
2. Permission must be obtained from the Geneseo Town Board no less than one month prior to the event. The Town of Geneseo is entitled to exercise its sole discretion in determining to approve or deny an application.
3. The Town Board reserves the right to limit the sale and consumption of alcohol to a specific area.
4. The person signing the permit application must be an authorized member of the company or organization.
5. The applicant shall obtain any other permits required for the dispensing of alcoholic beverages, including but not limited to any liquor permits required by New York State. In addition, the applicant must submit a certificate of insurance. Refer to application for insurance limits.
6. Alcohol may only be dispensed in non-glass containers and must remain in the designated areas of the park. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the beach and in the swimming area.
7. All local and State Laws in relation to the serving or dispensing of alcoholic beverages must be followed
8. Permit holders who fail to adhere to these rules will be subject to consequences up to and including revocation of their permit.

Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: none.

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

At 7:45 p.m. Councilman Wrubel moved and Councilman Griffo seconded the motion to enter into Executive Session to discuss the employment of a particular person. Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: None.

At 8:45 p.m. Councilman Griffo moved and Councilman Wrubel seconded the motion to exit Executive Session, with no action taken. Motion passed with voting as follows: Irwin-aye, Wrubel-aye, LaVigne-aye, Griffo-aye. Nays: None.

At 8:46 p.m. Councilman Wrubel moved and Councilwoman LaVigne seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
