1. HEARING OPENED:

Mayor Hatheway opened the public hearing at 7:15PM, noting that the appropriate notification had been published. The hearing was scheduled two weeks ago to review and amend several sections of the Code. However, the changes to the sections of Code are not in their final form. The sections are not of any great substance, but rather inconsistencies that need to be corrected. One of them is for planning board and appeals board member terms. They need to be set on an administrative rather than a calendar year basis. Also, Code Officers Maxwell and O'Keefe have pointed out several sections of the new zoning code that need to be either revised or clarified. Deputy Mayor Brennan plans to meet with Ron, Dean and Deputy Clerk Mack tomorrow to go over those sections.

There are several issues with the vehicle and traffic section of the Code also. Sgt. Carson inventoried all the stop signs and other traffic control signs in the Village. For example, all stop intersections must be listed in the Code. Along with that, Chief Osganian asks that the Board consider specific intersections in the Village with respect to prohibiting left turns during certain hours of the workday.

Considering that these items need to be reviewed, clarified and listed before a public hearing can properly take place, the Board agreed to close this hearing and set another hearing for May 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:15PM. The entire list of changes will be ready for review by the public at least a week prior to that hearing.

2. HEARING CLOSED:

Trustee Hill moved and Trustee LaGrou seconded the motion to close the public hearing. The vote was as follows: Deputy Mayor Brennan-Aye, Trustee Fox-Aye, Trustee Hill-Aye, Trustee LaGrou-Aye, and Mayor Hatheway-Aye. The motion passed and the hearing closed at 7:30PM.
