

**Minutes of the Geneseo Town Board Meeting
FEBRUARY 28, 2024**

Meeting Opening:

Deputy Supervisor Griffo called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM and Councilmember Deming led the group in the pledge to the flag. Deputy Supervisor Griffo requested a moment of silence to be held for service men and women serving around the world.

Approval of Minutes:

Councilmember Deming moved, and Councilmember Mix seconded the motion to approve the February 14, 2024, meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried with Wadsworth-absent, Deming-aye, Maxwell-absent, Mix-aye, and Griffo-aye. Nays: None.

Deputy Supervisor Griffo introduced the Board Members, Highway/Water Superintendent Levey, and himself to the representatives of the Geneseo Crew Club and suggested both the Town and Crew Club members stay connected with each other to stay up to date on what is happening at Long Point Park.

The annual agreement between the Town and the Geneseo Crew Club for the use of the boat house at Long Point Park is up for renewal and the Board took the following action:

Renew the Boat House Agreement with the Geneseo Crew Club:

Councilmember Deming moved, and Councilmember Maxwell seconded the motion to renew the agreement with the Geneseo Crew Club at the same amount as last year (\$1000.00) with an expiration date of November 30, 2024. Motion carried with Wadsworth-absent, Deming-aye, Griffo-aye, Maxwell-aye, and Mix-aye. Nays: None.

A letter was received from the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery Association requesting financial help with the mowing of the cemetery this year. The estimated amount needed is \$12,000 to \$15,000. The Board will act when invoices are presented.

Update - Pedestrian and traffic safety Board:

Councilmember Mix gave the Board the following update:

- March 4, 2024 – Meeting to develop a task analysis.
- March 12, 2024 - next meeting.
- Traffic monitoring will take place next month.
- A letter was drafted and will be sent in response to the letter received by Jennifer Chan regarding a school zone on Avon Geneseo Road.
- I Will contact Undersheriff Bean for accident information on Routes 20A and 39.
- Received a letter from DOT written to the Town Supervisor and Village Mayor.
- Matrix letter was sent to Planning Board Chair Robert Harris – It is being reviewed and comments will be given to Councilmember Mix.

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Update - New Town Property:

Deputy Supervisor Griffo and Highway/Water Superintendent Levey gave the following update:

- A message was sent to the company that does the penetration study and have not heard back will follow up again tomorrow.
- The purchase agreement states that the utilities are municipally owned but the property is on septic.
- The Highway/Water Superintendent has produced a drawing as to where sewer lines should go to hook up to the municipal sewer. The drawings have been submitted to the owner of the adjacent property.
- The Highway Department can perform the work.
- Will try to get on the agenda for the March 28, 2024, Village Planning Board meeting for a sketch plan review.

Update – New Website:

Councilmember Deming stated that he met with the website designer and gave her the Town of Geneseo's logo. They will produce some ideas to combine the Town and Village logos. A launch date is hopeful for some time in March.
