Meeting Opened:

Mayor Ivers opened the meeting at 5pm. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Update:

Mayor Ivers informed the Board of a meeting with Geneseo Central School regarding adding a crosswalk. He stated that the school was receptive to the idea and would provide and train the crossing guards. He continued with the hope that an easement for the path would be in place in the future. Superintendent Quinlan would look into the cost involved.

ARPA:

There was much discussion regarding the remaining balance of ARPA funds and the items already earmarked to be used. It was decided that all the earmarked items would continue to be supported by ARPA funds. Discussion continued with the items submitted by the department heads. After much back-and-forth discussion the Board decided on the majority of the expenditures, deciding to wait on a few more quotes before finalizing the appropriation.

Executive Session:

Board Updates/Information:

Fire Department: Trustee Livingston updated the Board that the ladder truck was still under repair.

Traffic Safety Committee: Trustee Lee inquired about a survey to change an intersection on South Street and Groveland Road. There was much discussion regarding traffic calming, and it was decided that any survey should include all aspects and possible solutions.
