**Meeting Opening:**

Supervisor Wadsworth convened the meeting at 4:30 p.m., with Deputy Councilmember Deming leading the group in the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Wadsworth then requested a moment of silence to honor the men and women serving around the world.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Deputy Supervisor Griffo proposed the motion, which was seconded by Councilmember Deming, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on April 8, 2026. The motion was adopted with the following votes: Wadsworth - aye, Deming - aye, Reiz - abstain, Mix - aye, and Griffo - aye. No nays were recorded.

**Approval of Abstract #5 of 2026:**

Councilmember Deming proposed the motion, which was seconded by Councilmember Ritz, to approve Abstract #5 of 2026 as they stand.

Visitor Gretchen Crane addressed the Board regarding payment to Temple Hill Cemetery. She stated that the cemetery is experiencing financial difficulties and expressed hope that the Town would issue a check for one-half of the requested amount.

The Town Board requested a breakdown detailing how the funds would be spent.

Supervisor Wadsworth stated that he would look into whether a check had already been issued.

**Accept the Standard Workday and Reporting Resolution:**

Deputy Supervisor Griffo proposed the motion, which was seconded by Councilmember Reitz, to approve the Standard Workday and Reporting Resolution for Councilmember Robert Deming. The resolution is to be posted for 30 days then sent to NYS retirement. The motion was adopted with the following votes: Wadsworth - aye, Deming - abstain, Reitz - aye, Mix - aye, and Griffo - aye. No nays were recorded.

**Allow Supervisor Wadsworth to Sign the Tour de Cure Letter:**

Councilmember Reitz proposed the motion, which was seconded by Councilmember Deming, to allow Supervisor Wadsworth to sign a letter allowing the Tour de Cure Race to take place on town roads on June 6, 2026. The motion was adopted with the following votes: Wadsworth - aye, Deming - aye, Reitz - aye, Mix - aye, and Griffo - aye. No nays were recorded.

Councilmember Reitz opened a discussion regarding the possibility of changing the start time for Town Board meetings. Discussion included potential meeting times, resident attendance at meetings, and whether meetings should be made accessible remotely. The matter will be discussed further at the Organizational Meeting.

**Open Items – Town Board:**

Councilmembers Reitz and Deming discussed the proposed Comprehensive Plan Update and presented a detailed draft outlining the proposed consultant scope of work.

Councilmember Deming stated that he will work on obtaining proposals from consultants.

Councilmember Mix noted that the Town Board members and the Highway Department received a thank-you note for their assistance in repairing the kiosk at Long Point Park.

**Enter into Executive Session:**

Councilmember Deming proposed the motion, which was seconded by Deputy Supervisor Griffo, to enter into executive session to discuss the employment history of a particular person at 5:14 PM. The motion was adopted with the following votes: Wadsworth - aye, Deming - aye, Reitz - aye, Mix - aye, and Griffo - aye. No nays were recorded.
